Reason:	An accident to a Eurostar occurred when one flap retracted during the landing approach which led to an uncontrollable roll. The cause was a wing flap actuator pin which was not properly engaged in the flap and which disengaged from the flap when the flaps were extended.  Insufficient engagement of the wing flap actuator pins into the guides in the flap root ribs may cause wear of the guides. In extreme cases the pin or guide may fail causing a loss of flap controllability.
